Designated Focus: Youth and Young Adults

Job Purpose:

Our mission is to reach out and serve all people as we grow in relationship with Jesus Christ and each other.

The Coordinator of Youth and Young Adult Ministries will strive to build young disciples for Christ by implementing a comprehensive, intergenerational approach to this age-level ministry that considers the spiritual gifts of its members, supports them in their Christian journey, and encourages them to share their discipleship with the world.

Responsibilities and Accountabilities:

Youth Ministry:

1. Work with the Director of Discipleship to plan, develop, and execute a varied and wide-ranging program with youth, which includes worship, Bible study, discipleship, fellowship, evangelism, mission, and service.
2. Implement active ongoing communication with youth, utilizing various means and media.
3. Work with the Director of Discipleship to develop and implement Youth Ministry Council to support the avenue of youth ministry.
4. Work with the Director of Discipleship to act as liaison with community and church organizations, people, and resources that relate to youth and youth ministries.

Young Adult Ministry:

1. Work with the Director of Discipleship to create a welcoming environment and sense of community for young adults and mentor young adults as they develop in their Christian walk.
2. Actively communicate with young adults regarding avenues of participation in the life of the church, in church leadership and other servant roles, and in outreach opportunities.
3. Coordinate small group opportunities and recruit leaders in cooperation with the Education Committee.

Minimum Qualifications:

Education: Some college-level study in the areas of Youth Ministry, Christian Education, and or pre-ministerial study is expected. Previous experience in youth and young adult ministry is preferred. Basic understanding and appreciation of United Methodist theology is required.

Experience: Have demonstrated ability to organize and implement a broad program of youth and young adult discipleship.

Other Minimum Qualifications: Excellent written and verbal communication skills and computer aptitude, including social media. Pass Criminal Background Check.
